
The Welcoming Center's **Global Enterprise Hub** provides services

English for Entrepreneurs


E4E is a 8-Week, 32-hour course that covers:

- Build community (network with municipal agencies, business assoc., nonprofits & fellow merchants)
- Bookkeeping, inventory control & negotiation
